## **U.DANCE Cumbria 2018**

Your school is invited to be part of U.DANCE Cumbria 2018. Organised by Cumbria County Council, U.DANCE supports schools to create high quality creative dance within the curriculum & to celebrate this through performance.

Last year's performance was truly stunning; we would definitely encourage you to take part!

A secondary schools performance will take place at Theatre by the Lake, Keswick on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February, 7.00pm. The event enables KS3/4 pupils and teachers to see each other's work, share practice, raise aspirations and celebrate achievement. Unlike Rock Challenge, U.DANCE Cumbria is non-competitive but it does offer the opportunity to be nominated for One Dance UK's prestigious awards for Outstanding Choreography and Best Performance.

Schools are required to choreograph a 3 minute (minimum) dance from scratch either on their own, if confident enough, or with the help of a visiting dance artist.

We welcome applications from all secondary schools and sixth form colleges across the county. The maximum number of pupils per group is 25 due to on-stage & behind-the-scenes space restrictions at this venue.

We especially welcome secondary schools who have not previously participated.

There are 12 places available to secondary schools. A selection process may be applied if the event is over-subscribed where priority will be given to schools that:-

- have not previously participated
- encourage NQTs or teachers new to the school/festival to lead this task
- have worked with a dance artist previously but who now feel confident enough to create work on their own
- demonstrate strong creative leadership & excellence in dance

You can, of course, opt to perform as part of your 'local' U.DANCE event alongside your feeder primary schools in Carlisle, Workington, Barrow or Kendal **instead of or as well as** the secondary-only performance at Keswick. If you would like to perform twice, both at your 'local' U.DANCE event **AND** at the secondary-only performance at Keswick, then an additional £50 is payable to your 'local' fee. Please indicate your performance preferences on the attached application form.

The key features of U.DANCE are:-

 a compulsory practical half day INSET session led by Kelly McClelland. The teacher who is responsible for the group must attend the INSET which will cover logistical information about each









venue/performance as well as practical ideas for creating & rehearsing choreography, music selection & editing. The INSET gives teachers the chance to meet Rachel Towe, who will be the performance co-ordinator for the secondary school's performance, and also to meet your dance artist if you have requested one.

**Secondary INSET -** Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November, 9.00am- 12.00pm, Newbiggin Village Hall, Newbiggin, Penrith, CA11 0HT.

- a dance artist to work in your school for 4 x 1 hour workshops to help create and refine your dance. (You may opt to produce a dance on your own if you have participated before or if you have sufficient experience and confidence in leading dance.)
- a visit, if needed, from your festival coordinator whilst you are creating your piece to offer helpful advice and guidance
- a technical rehearsal at the performance venue on the day of the performance
- a performance opportunity at Theatre by the Lake, Keswick, Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2018, 7.00pm

Technical rehearsals will be held at Theatre by the Lake (starting at 3.00pm) during the afternoon of the performance. This is the opportunity for students & teachers to see the quality of work being produced by other schools around the county.

For schools working on their own the cost is £130; for schools working with a dance artist the cost is £230. Schools will be invoiced during the autumn term. This payment is non-refundable if a school pulls out after a place has been allocated to them.

Tickets for this performance will be sold through the Box Office at Theatre by the Lake at the price of £8.00 each. Tickets will go on sale on Monday  $8^{th}$  January 2018.

If you would like to take part in U.DANCE Cumbria 2018 please complete & return the attached form by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Late applications will not be considered. Schools will be notified of selection by email during October half term.
