

Caudwell Children is a pan-disability charity that provides a variety of services and support to disabled children and their families across the UK.

One of our **core services** is the provision of sports equipment and we are the second largest voluntary **provider of sports equipment** in the UK. As part of this service we have partnered with The Edward Gostling Foundation who are **match funding** donations up to 50% to help fund sports chairs and equipment for disabled children.

Our motto is to do "Whatever it takes" – we strive to continuously support and fundraise for young disabled people who want to be more active and to continue on this mission we are looking to form partnerships across the country who share the same vision.

Our collaboration with your local Active Partnership?

Active Partnerships will help in identifying local disabled person(s) aged under 25 who may need support with equipment to fully engage in their chosen sport.

What Caudwell Children will provide is the help and support to the Active Partner networks to fundraise between £5,000 to £10,000 to coincide with the Edward Gostling Foundation match funding.

Our long-term goal

We aim to:

- Create a light-touch but long-term partnership with Active Partnerships across England
- Develop a sustainable identification process for young people whom are prevented from being more active because of chair and equipment costs
- Establish a fundraising week in each county for young people with disabilities requiring access to sports chair and equipment.

Young Person Eligible Criteria

The young person must:

- Be aged under 25 years
- Have an income or family income of less than £45,000 gross (excluding benefits)
- Have legal residence in the UK
