

# THE RECONDITIONING FUND APPLICATION PROCESS AND GRANTS FLOWCHART

Stage One

Applicant completes an expression of interest (EOI) and submits to Active Cumbria (AC)

Stage Two

AC will discuss with applicant barriers to completion and if they are still interested in The Reconditioning Fund

Applicant does not complete eLearning within allocated time

AC provide applicant with Live Longer Better eLearning licence to be completed within 4 weeks

Applicant completes eLearning within allocated time and decides to apply to The Reconditioning Fund

Applicant completes eLearning within allocated time and decides not to apply to The Reconditioning Fund

With support of AC Officer, applicant's project is developed and captured on application form

Application is reviewed by AC Grant Awards panel with feedback

Applicant submits application form to AC panel for consideration at next available Award Panel meeting

Applicant is invited to join Live Longer Better in Cumbria Network

Within the funding lifetime, applicant decides to apply to The Reconditioning Fund

Application is approved by AC panel and applicant is notified with 14 days of the decision

Applicant signs Grant Offer Letter and returns to AC

Applicant is invited to join Live Longer Better in Cumbria Network

Funding is released to applicant

Applicant completes all monitoring and evaluation as required by AC during life course of the project
